How does the MMASC Annual Conference Golf Outing work?



Teams of 4

Teams are usually randomly assigned, if you have a team of 4 that would like to play together, please notify the co-chairs.



Tee Off

Every person on the team takes 1 stroke.



Play From the Best Shot

All 4 players hit from the best stroke. The process of playing the best ball of the team after every drive or stroke continues until the ball is holed. The outing is a full 18-hole round.



Score

Every person on the team receives the same score.

What do I wear?

Gentlemen: Khakis, slacks, shorts, polo/collared shirt, closed toe shoes
Ladies: Slacks, bermuda shorts, skirts, polos, sports tanktop, closed toe shoes

*No Jeans

What do I bring?

Your own clubs is encouraged but not necessary (rental opportunities available), golf balls, golf tees, sunscreen, cash for bar purchases and most importantly: readiness to have fun!

What is the point?

This golf outing is all about enjoying the morning and getting to know MMASC members and partners.

What if I'm not good?

Many of us have never played before or play once a year. One thing to keep in mind, there has never been a golf outing where at least 1 of the 4 players has not said "This is my first time," or "I haven't hit a golf ball in years". Don't worry, you're in good company!

What if I'm REALLY not good?

Lucky for you, we have a max score of bogey per hole. Ask any regular golfer how much they would give to consistently get a bogey on every hole (our guess its 99%). Odds are with a team behind you, you will shoot your best score ever on a golf course.
